ISLAM, LOVE AND MARRIAGE: NEW CHOICES FOR A NEW WORLD

Dr Santi Rozario's research project, *The Challenge of Islam: Young Bangladeshis, Marriage and Family in Bangladesh and the UK*, is a study of how young Bangladeshi Muslims think about marriage and the family. It is funded by the Economic and Social Research Council (ESRC, UK) and based at Cardiff University in the UK.

One of the main attractions of new versions of Islam is that they offer solutions to the problems faced by Muslim families in today's rapidly changing world. Santi and her colleagues have been studying how marriage and the family are changing among young Bangladeshi women and men, within and outside Bangladesh. They have also been studying relevant Islamic organisations, both through their writings and through interviews and participant observation.

With the research nearly concluded, they are presenting some of their results at this workshop, taking place at Dhaka University with the support of Professor Kazi Nurul Islam of the Department of World Religions and Culture, and hosted by the Department's Centre for Interreligious and Intercultural Dialogue.
